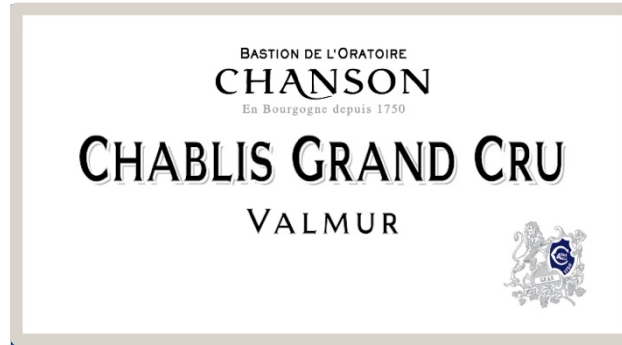

## 2015 VINTAGE

“There is notably more classic Chablis character to the much cooler nose that combines hints of iodine and oyster shell with those of citrus, pear and soft wood scents. There is a highly attractive vibrancy and tension to the more mineral-driven flavors that terminate in a saline and markedly dry finale. This is much less 2015 in style than the Bougros.”
