“A distinctly ripe nose reflects notes of poached plum, mocha, newly turned earth and forest floor with a background hint of leather. The sleek, intense and solidly voluminous middle weight flavors exude a more subtle minerality on the muscular but not rustic finish. This needs to develop better depth but the supporting structure makes clear that this will need plenty of time before it will be entirely ready”.
