

## 2010 VINTAGE

"They picked the grapes of the contract growers and vinified themselves in the new winery. A purple aroma. Very primary. Juicy and quite simple with rather stinky tannins. The fruit is sappy and bright, but there is some greenness. This was 70% whole bunch. It is at the end of the MLF so there is the effect of creamy lactic and the wood."
